

Klaipėda is currently a strong location for **testing**, **component manufacturing and small-scale extraction for the Oil & Gas industry** – making it a natural competence centre for this sector.

A feasibility study for the production of liquefied CO2 and hydrogen is planned to be carried out in Klaipėda. An agreement was reached between Lithuania's oil and LNG terminal operator Klaipėdos Nafta (KN), together with Norwegian ship management company Larvik Shipping (LS) and Japanese multi-modal maritime transport company Mitsui O.S.K. Lines (MOL). The entire concept shall be to develop an LCO2 logistics and value chain from Lithuania and potentially the Baltic region with Klaipeda seaport at the center.

Talent incentive

Municipal Talent incentive
Highly qualified specialists that come from abroad or other Lithuanian cities and work under an employment contract for at least one year are entitled to receive €2000 for housing rent compensation (per application), €400 for Lithuanian courses (per application), and assistance with integration for the whole family.

National talent incentive pays ~3000 Eur. one-off compensation for international talent coming to Lithuania.

Companies that hire an eligible highly skilled employee from abroad shall be granted a **financial initiative for the search efforts** of not more than 5000 EUR per each eligible employee.

Ground, sea, and air pathways for logistics

The port connects Klaipėda to everyone across and beyond the Baltic Sea. Rail and road connections enhance connectivity further to Asia and the Eastern part of Europe. Plus, Klaipėda International Airport is just a 30-minute drive away, connecting to business hubs in Scandinavia, Riga, and London.







Thinking about their future

Lithuania is one of the few European countries that has started the renewal of IT education. Further more, Klaipėda City Municipality seeks to create a sustainable education value chain from primary (IT programs) to gymnasium (engineering classes in collaboration with university and business).

Klaipėda City Municipality seeks to develop IT skills from an early age in the city, so invests in Primary school teachers and learners through the Teachers Lead Tech program in all of Klaipėda's primary schools.

The model of **early engineering education** is being developed in Klaipėda's Baltija Gymnasium. Engineering profile classes cooperate with 7 companies, whose engineers share their experience and teach students the subtleties of the field through hands-on work. The gymnasium works closely with Klaipėda University, and vocational schools and Klaipėda State University of Applied Sciences are expected to join the model.


